In many ways, we think that the situation for children involved with Child Welfare has gotten worse rather than better.

As was always the case, the reasons are manifold. One can point to the fact that there no longer is a Ministry specifically for Children and Families, that the Office of the Children’s Advocate was closed, that funding is insufficient, that there is a lack of treatment facilities for children with complex needs, that Child Welfare no longer has capacity, or sufficient capacity, to take preventative measures. And as was always the case, poverty and racism have a pervasive impact.

We want to thank everyone who were members, who came to speak to us, who provided funds, who participated in focus groups and so many more contacts we made over the years. And especially a huge thanks to the young people who educated us. We still have much to learn.
